We are still going into the Federal Prisons preaching and teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ. As one of our Chaplain's has been deployed to Europe in the military, we can only go to prison in the two prisons here in Oakdale, LA three times each week. There have been eight men saved since our last letter! It is our joy that the men are growing and receiving the Word of God. Without you we could not do this ministry. The Lord will reward you for your faithfulness to pray and give!

Many have asked about Lou's health. She isn't able to go with me to prison as she can't walk without a walker. She has had several MRI's lately, but still has some results pending. This January 23 we will get the results of the last one. Please pray with me that she will soon be able to walk without the walker. She is now in physical therapy twice a week and seems to be doing better with her walking. She still grades the lessons sent to us for the Bible Institute from the inmates. In the last three weeks there has been fifteen new men who have started taking the lessons. Praise God for His goodness. I am doing well physically.

We were able to buy a 2015 Dodge Journey through financing it through our bank. We still owe a little over \$2,000.00. Thanks to all who have sent in monies to help pay for it.

Thank all who have prayed and sacrificed to help us preach the gospel to the inmates. God bless each of you. Please remember that we are praying for you!
