




# the Mullers

Every year we have a full house with lots of visitors and every year the Lord is faithful to allow us to see people saved to the glory of God.

Not only do we have our special day in our main church in the city, but we also have 2 village churches where we have a special day planned. It keeps us busy to say the least.

Speaking of our village works, (we call them missions), both of them are seeing the increase from the Lord. Our work in Samahil has started Sunday evening services and brother Abraham has reported that for the last month there have been visitors to every service and there has been someone saved every Sunday. Praise the Lord for his faithfulness. We

have made several improvements to the property this year, including finishing a bathroom, and making a separate room for the adolescents to meet on Sunday, along with a new roof for our main meeting area. Our prayer is that in 2026 we will be able to build a church building.

We plan to start a fund in our church here and as we progress we will ask others to give as the Lord allows. We will keep you updated as we move forward. I believe we can build a decent building for around \$ 25,000 all told.

Our second village church is also growing steadily and surely. We are still some time from thinking about a building, but we have begun praying for our own piece of property. Right now, we are on borrowed land of one of the ladies who was saved in our outreach.

If you could keep these 2 projects before the Lord, it would be much appreciated.

In closing, let us say again how grateful we are to the Lord for each and every one of you who faithfully support us with your financial gifts and prayers. May God continue to bless your efforts.
