It has been quite a time that we could not go into prison to minister. Praise the Lord, the Federal Prison in Oakdale, LA is open to us again. I had my first class this past Thursday. I received my schedule to go into the prison. I am now able to minister Tuesday – Wednesday from one until three in the afternoons, then on Thursdays, from 12 noon until 3 P.M. Very soon I will be preaching Sunday 6:30 until 7:30; and Monday 6:30-7:30 plus my class during the week! I am so excited about being able to preach and teach again in the prison.

Lou has had doctor's appointments nearly every week for several months. She is in a lot of pain because of her spine is twisted and has spurs on it. After two visits to receive shots, she is not hurting like before. Of course, the shots are only temporary. Please continue to pray for her.

Our son, Adam, has a kidney stone in each kidney, called Stag Horn stones. They are too large to pass. He is to be operated on the fifteenth of December. Please pray for him also.

My back has given me a lot of trouble, but I can still go. The doctor told Lou that I needed to come in for shots again. It has been two years since the last shots. God is still in control.

AGAIN, please pray for the men in prison that I will be ministering. Nearly all of the ones that were there when we had to leave are in other prisons or have gone home. I will practically be starting over. There are many souls to be saved and taught the Word of God.

Thanks so much for your faithfulness to pray and support the ministry God has begun in us. Know that we are praying for you.
