I am thankful that I was still able to do the radio broadcasts through the summer, and every chance I had I gave out tracts. I try to carry a "leaky seed basket" everywhere I go! It is a blessing to go to my office (which is also the radio studio) at the Fellowship Tract League building, walk in the door, and hear the presses running! What a joy to know that the precious Word of God is being printed: that it could be read by a lost sinner, and their eternal destiny could be changed! We underestimate the power contained in that little piece of paper! IT IS GOD'S WORD!!!!

I just want to say thank you to all those who have been praying for me, and also to those who faithfully support our ministry. And a special thank you to those who gave extra to meet the needs. Please know that we are very grateful! God has used His people to supply all our needs and more! We love you, and pray for you daily!
