The last few months we have seen an increase in our church services. There are a few new families worshipping with us, and that is always good. The hope is always that they become integrated and begin serving the Lord alongside us.

As you may know, we serve in 2 small villages outside of our city, and this last month we began holding Sunday evening services in Samahil, where we have been working for about 5 years. This is an exciting step towards this work becoming an Independent Baptist Church, and we appreciate prayers for wisdom in this new undertaking.

On another note, we've been busy saying goodbye to a few saints. We commended the soul of our sister Nieryeda last month, and she will be missed, but we are thankful that we were a part of her spiritual journey. She lived a good long life and is now in the presence of her Savior.

Last month we also were called to minister to one of our families in one of our village works. Roberto, a 20 year old young man who had been a part of our Jr Church lost his life in a motorcycle accident. It was hard to say the least, a closed coffin due to his remains having been found after 3 days on the side of the road. Many from our church went to console and minister.

Just last week another young man, 16 years old, Jhosef, lost his life in an accidental electrocution. At the wake over 50 young people came to say good bye, at the graveside there were many many people there and I was able to give the

gospel, our prayers are that God's word will find good ground and bring forth life eternal.

It's hard to experience loss, but I feel that it is exceptionally hard when it's a young person. We're praying that the Lord will do a work through these difficult moments.

We have our annual Bible Conference scheduled in the next weeks, we desire to be a blessing to local pastors. Every year we have 3 days of preaching in the morning, lunch, then afternoon service. By God's grace we have been able to give each visiting pastor materials for study, for evangelism and boxes of bibles, along with some great bible teaching from our guest preachers, which are always gratefully received. We're praying that this year we can continue the help that God provides through our church.

As we close out 2025 we are grateful for God's presence, the many times he has visited with us as a church, the increase he has given and the many souls saved and baptized this year. We are also appreciative of your prayers and financial support that hold the rope while we serve here in the Yucatan.

May God continue to give you all the increase as well.

We are very appreciative of your ministry and we don't take it for granted. We will be sending along something to help with your ministry as soon as we can.
