We praise God for what He is doing in the prison here. Our prisoners Bible Institute is growing. We now have over sixty men studying the Bible in their cells. Praise the Lord for the solid foundation they are receiving from the Word of God. It is so great to read the essays that they are writing on their lesson.

Since our last letter there has been six men who have trusted our Lord Jesus Christ as personal Savior. We are surely thankful to Christ for still using us to reach people. Although I am eighty years old, I still love to preach and teach the Word of God. This week we were not able to go to prison except on Sunday due to a Covid restriction. The Chaplain of our prison said that it should just be for a short time, then back to the privilege that God has given us.

Yesterday afternoon we received two cases of Spanish Bibles that we will be placing in our prison this next week. Romans 10:17 says, "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God". We are thankful to the ones who send money to purchase Bibles. Nearly all to the men have their own Bibles now that they can study in their cells. Praise God for His goodness.
