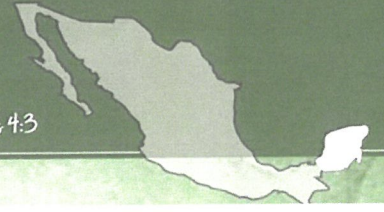

missionaries to Mexico

Greeting from the south peninsula of Mexico. As always, we are thankful to the Lord for your prayers and financial support of our ministry here in the Yucatan.

As we look ahead to the summer months upon us we have a busy schedule. In June we have 2 events that we have every year, Father's Day and our Youth Rally both fall in the month of June, and there is a lot of planning that goes into both. This year's goal for the Youth Rally is to break 150 in attendance. Last year we came close with just over 130, which is a good group of kids.

This year our Father's Day is going to be a little different, we decided that we would have a bar-b-que at a rented salon on a Saturday, so we're praying that there will be a good response. Our church has about 40 men who are regularly in our church services. The thing is in this part of the world most men work 6 days a week and rarely have much free time for themselves. That translates to we have a good group of men in your morning service but very few come back for the afternoon service opting to take some time either to sleep or take the family somewhere.

Then in July we have 2 more events that involve the whole church. Our VBS and the Youth Camp, and as we move forward with those plans we would ask that in both your prayers would be that Christ would be lifted up and people would be saved.

The last few months of ministry here in our church have been good. We have visitors almost every Sunday, and we see a few of them return. We had some baptisms in May, and we rejoiced in seeing new believers obey the Lord in believer's Baptists.

Just last Sunday, we had a couple visiting and at the end of the service they came forward to hear how to be saved and both received the gift of salvation. They are our neighbors who live just a few doors down,

and I was so glad to see them come to our service. Pray for José and Angelica and for us as we ask for wisdom in how we can minister them. That makes 5 families on my block that are coming to our church, it's a blessing to be able to reach your neighbors for the Lord.

Last week, I was able to host a pastor's breakfast at our church. We had 16 attend and I was really happy that we could get together and consider a theme we had picked out the month before, Practice and Doctrine. It was edifying and thoughtful. Every month we meet at a different church with a theme that we all agree on. Next month we will pick the theme of Missions and guess who is giving the challenge. Since I am a missionary, they all looked at me and said you teach us about missions. I will do so happily. Our church currently supports 8 missionaries and as they were visiting with me, our missions wall provoked several comments, which led to them desiring to know how we can spend so much on missions. I look forward to the next pastor's breakfast.
