It's been an active last few months and it doesn't seem to be slowing down.

Samahil Mission Work Our work in the village of Samahil took a great step forward last month when we started holding Sunday services. Our team now goes on Sunday morning, and although we miss them in our church service in Merida, we know it's for the best, and already we are seeing the increase that God is giving. There have been visitors and people getting saved. Please continue to pray for the direction of this work, and we also are asking for help with a construction need there. We have built a bathroom. a storage room and another room for the Teen Ministry, but we also need a wall around the property. We have one side of the property done, but we need to see the rest completed. I think it will be around \$ 3500 to finish it for the labor and materials, so if you can help with that, we would be very thankful.

- Youth Group
Last month we had a Teen Rally at our church in Merida. We invited several other churches to bring their youth, and we had just under 150 in attendance. It was a great time of fellowship for them, as they played Volleyball and Soccer, and a few other games. After the message 6 teens

came forward for salvation, praise the Lord! It seems that the Lord is enlarging our tent as

2 new churches who came to the activity have never been to one of the events. It was a pleasure to get to know the leaders and pastors of these churches and we pray we can work together to further the gospel.

- Highways and Hedges Ministry
About 2 years ago we were given an open
door of ministry to small rural local churches.
We go to a village, or pueblo as we call
them and hold a small evangelistic
campaign. I come into contact with a
lot of pastors that serve in these rural
ministries, and we offer to help them
with some evangelism. Sometimes
they just want to see some soul
winning where they are, other times

they have a desire to start a work in a neighboring village, but the truth is they lack some basic resources. Without exception all of these pastors work fulltime jobs as

their respective churches are unable to support them. Our church is able to provide some of those things, like Bibles, John and Romans, gospel tracts and a team to evangelize for an afternoon. Last year we saw the Lord open up 4 different villages where a new church was started in a new village where there had been none before. Exponentially multiplying the fruit with which our church

alone could never have done. This co laboring effort is exciting and we pray we can continue to work with more village churches and see the increase in churches planted.
